**ORDER**

Upon consideration of Plaintiffs’ Uncontested Motion for Clarification of Scope of Preliminary Injunction and in light of Defendants’ non-opposition to that motion, the preliminary injunction entered on June 4, 2014 is clarified as follows:


**PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

Defendants, their agents, officers, and employees, and all others in active concert or participation with them, are hereby ENJOINED AND RESTRAINED from any effort to apply or enforce, as to all members of The Catholic Benefits Association LCA as of June 4, 2014 (“June 4 Members”) that either qualify for the accommodation (Group II members), as defined by 26 C.F.R. § 54.9815-2713A(a), 29 C.F.R. § 2590.715-2713A(a), and 45 C.F.R. § 147.131(b), or neither qualify for the “religious employer” exemption nor qualify for the accommodation (Group III members), the substantive requirements at issue in this case that are imposed by 42 U.S.C. § 300gg-13(a)(4) and its related

regulations, including any penalties, fines, and assessments for noncompliance with the provisions (the “Mandate”), until further order of the Court.

Defendants, their agents, officers, and employees, and all others in active concert or participation with them, are FURTHER ENJOINED AND RESTRAINED from any effort to apply or enforce the Mandate against group insurers and third-party administrators of the June 4 Members and from interfering with the June 4 Members’ attempts to arrange or contract for morally compliant health or stop-loss coverage or related services for their employees.
